RECENTLY COMPLETED:

Pavement removal markings including sidewalk and driveways for the project are ongoing.

Sawcutting of pavement is ongoing.

Preconstruction Meeting was held on May 3rd.

COMING UP THIS WEEK:

Hulstein Excavating will continue sawcutting the pavement, including sidewalks and driveways, but will not be removing the pavement at this time.

COMING SOON:

May 15th:

- Milling of the asphalt pavement and removal of the curb and gutter from 16th to 20th Street.
- Storm Sewer pipe arriving on site.
- Temporary Mailboxes installed (location to be determined by the Postmaster).
- Existing mailboxes to be removed and stored on owner's property.
- Contact the City (Travis W.) if you have an existing sprinkler system.

May 22nd:

• Begin concrete removals.

May 29th:

• Begin storm sewer installation starting at 16th Street.
