RESOLUTION ADOPTING LOCAL OPTION SALES TAX ALLOCATION AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF HAWARDEN, IOWA, AND HAWARDEN CITY HOSPITAL BOARD OF TRUSTEES FOR REVENUE SHARING

WHEREAS, the City Council of Hawarden, Iowa and the Hawarden Hospital Board of Trustees have been in discussions concerning sharing a portion of the revenues generated by the Local Option Sales Tax as was authorized in the citizen vote to levy the tax; and

WHEREAS, the two boards have reached an amicable agreement for a sharing schedule subject to review to see that the purposes of the tax continue to be fulfilled; and,

WHEREAS, the Hawarden City Council has reviewed and discussed the provisions of a written Local Option Sales Tax Allocation Agreement for the retention by the City of a portion of the revenues and reviews of the retention of LOST revenues;

NOW, THEREFORE be it RESOLVED by the City Council of Hawarden, Iowa that:

The Mayor and City Administrator are hereby authorized and directed to execute the Agreement and take all actions necessary to place it into effect.
