

<p><b>Plastic</b></p> 	<p>All plastic containers labeled # 1-7            Milk and juice jugs            Pop and water bottles            Dish and liquid soap bottles            Bleach and detergent containers            Ice cream tubs and yogurt cups            Cooking oil containers            Lotion bottles            Household cleaning containers            Plastic bags &amp; plastic food wrap (Bagged in plastic bags)            Plastic cups              (clean, no liquids)</p>	<p><b>Plastic</b></p>	<p>Styrofoam &amp; packing peanuts            Plastic utensils, plates            Disposable baby &amp; adult diapers            Garden hose            Landscape plastic &amp; tile material, PVC pipes            Medical supplies and sharps            CDs, DVDs</p>
<p><b>Aluminum And metals</b></p>	<p>Aluminum &amp; tin cans            Aluminum foil &amp; pans            Aerosol spray cans (must be empty)</p>	<p><b>Glass</b></p>	<p>No glass will be accepted due to possible contamination of other materials.            Dinnerware &amp; glassware or ceramic material              CFL &amp; Fluorescent light bulbs (But are accepted at the Northwest IA Area Solid Waste Household Hazardous Material Regional Collection Center by appointment)</p>
<p><b>Corrugated Cardboard</b></p>	<p>Corrugated cardboard            Pizza boxes (no leftover pizza)            Break down and flatten, so more fits in recycling container</p>	<p><b>Batteries &amp; Cell phones</b></p>	<p>Due to fire hazard- no batteries and cell phones will be accepted at the Recycling Center.              (But are accepted at the Northwest IA Area Solid Waste Household Hazardous Material Regional Collection Center by appointment)</p>
